For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO ABOLISH THE ASSESSMENT COORDINATION
DEPARTMENT AND TRANSFER ITS DUTIES TO THE PUBLIC
SERVICE COMMISSION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

TO ABOLISH THE ASSESSMENT COORDINATION
DEPARTMENT AND TRANSFER ITS DUTIES TO
THE PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. (a) The Assessment Coordination Department, established under Arkansas Code § 25-28-101 et seq., and its powers, authorities, duties, functions, records, property, unexpended balances of appropriations, allocations, or other funds are transferred to the Public Service Commission.

(b) The duties transferred to the Public Service Commission under this act include the following:

- (1) Rulemaking;
- (2) Regulation;
- (3) Licensing;
- (4) Promulgation of rules, regulations, rates, or standards;
- (5) Licensing; and
- (6) The rendering of findings, orders, and adjudications.

(c) All positions at the Assessment Coordination Department shall be eliminated immediately before the transfer.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective on July 1, 2005.
