SECTION 3. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the current insurance market is volatile; that current insurance laws do not require insurance producers to obtain continuing education hours; that to protect consumers, insurance producers need to obtain continuing education hours that include at least (1) hour in ethics training; and that this act is immediately necessary to ensure that insurance producers are adequately informed of industry developments and to protect insurance purchasers in a volatile market. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become effective on July 1, 2003.

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
