19 (2) This subsection (e) shall not be applicable to any parent 20 who can present written acknowledgement that the child has been enrolled in a 21 public, private, or parochial school within thirty (30) days of the 22 administration of the state-mandated achievement test.

23 (f)(1) Each local school district shall have authority to assess any 24 home-schooled student who enrolls or reenrolls in the district in order to 25 determine proper educational placement.

(2) The local school district shall utilize, among other means
of assessment, the norm-referenced test approved by the board to assess the
student and shall determine placement in the appropriate grade level as
indicated by the test results assessment.

30 (g) Any home-schooled student who enrolls or reenrolls in a local 31 school district must attend classes for at least nine (9) months immediately 32 prior to graduation before the student can become eligible to receive a high 33 school diploma from the district.

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
