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2 WHEREAS, The State has to find an efficient method to use its limited 3 resources to create a system of public education as defined by Article 14, as 4 amended, of the Arkansas Constitution within the restraints that have been 5 placed on the state by both the current state of the economy and the 6 Constitution of the State of Arkansas,

8 NOW THEREFORE,

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9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTY-FOURTH GENERAL 10 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN: 11

12 That all state agencies, departments, institutions, and other 13 organizations interested in education, are encouraged to work together to 14 build the capacity of the state as a whole to provide the necessary 15 infrastructure and resources to ensure all children are afforded an equal 16 opportunity to obtain an adequate education.

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BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the General Assembly encourages meetings, dialogue, and collaboration aimed toward providing innovative and efficient solutions among various state agencies, departments, institutions, and other organizations interested in education, specifically including, but not limited to:

- 33 (11) Local school boards of directors; and
