15	AUTHORIZING A STUDY OF THE UNIFORM LEAVE
16	AND ATTENDANCE ACT AND THE HOLIDAY ACT
17	TO BETTER ACCOMMODATE STATE EMPLOYEES
18	WITH NON-TRADITIONAL WORK SCHEDULES.
19	
20	WHEREAS, the Uniform Leave and Attendance Act was passed in 1975 when
21	traditionally a work week was five (5) eight (8) hour days; and
22	
23	WHEREAS, the act establishing state holidays was also originally passed
24	in 1975; and
25	
26	WHEREAS, many state employees work non-traditional schedules including
27	twenty-four (24) hour days, twelve (12) hour days, or ten (10) hour days; and
28	
29	WHEREAS, legislation passed in the 2003 session provides a variation in
30	leave accrual for one classification in state government.
31	
32	NOW THEREFORE,
33	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTY-FOURTH GENERAL
34	OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:
35	
36	THAT the Public Health and Welfare Interim Committee shall complete a



1	study of the Uniform Leave and Attendance Act and the Holiday Act as they
2	relate to accrual and usage of holiday,, sick, and annual leave for state
3	employees working non-traditional hours.
4	
5	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the committee shall make recommendations
6	to the 2005 General Assembly if changes are needed.
