3	SECTION 1. Section 2 of Amendment 73 to the Constitution of the State
4	of Arkansas is amended to read as follows:
5	§ 2. Legislative Branch.
6	(a) <u>(l)</u> The Arkansas House of Representatives shall consist of members
7	to be chosen every second year by the qualified electors of the several
8	counties.
9	(2) No member of the Arkansas House of Representatives may serve
10	more than <del>three</del> <u>six</u> such two year terms.
11	(3) For purposes of this section, terms served in the House of
12	Representatives prior to January 1, 1993, the effective date of Amendment 73,
13	shall not be counted in calculating the number of terms served.
14	(b) <u>(1)</u> The Arkansas Senate shall consist of members to be chosen every
15	four years by the qualified electors of the several districts.
16	<u>(2)</u> No member of the Arkansas Senate may serve more than <del>two</del>
17	<u>three</u> such four year terms.
18	(3) For purposes of this section, terms served in the Arkansas
19	Senate prior to January 1, 1993, the effective date of Amendment 73, shall
20	not be counted in calculating the number of terms served.
