21	WHEREAS, President Ronald Wilson Reagan, a man of humble background,
22	worked throughout his life serving freedom and advancing the public good,
23	having been employed as an entertainer, union leader, corporate spokesman,
24	Governor of California, and President of the United States; and

26	WHEREAS, Ronald Reagan served with honor and distinction for two terms
27	as the 40th President of the United States of America, the second in which he
28	earned the confidence of three-fifths of the electorate and was victorious in
29	49 of the 50 states in the general election, a record unsurpassed in the
30	history of American presidential elections; and

32	WHEREAS, in 1981, when Ronald Reagan was inaugurated President, he
33	inherited a disillusioned nation shackled by rampant inflation and high
