20 WHEREAS, Miss Shelby Crawford, a young resident of Eureka Springs,  
21 Arkansas and a home-schooled student, has achieved national recognition for  
22 exemplary volunteer service by receiving the 2003 Prudential Spirit of  
23 Community Award; and

25 WHEREAS, the prestigious Prudential Spirit of Community Award,  
26 presented by Prudential Financial in partnership with the National  
27 Association of Secondary School Principals, honors young volunteers across  
28 America who have demonstrated an extraordinary commitment to serving their  
29 states and local communities; and

31 WHEREAS, Shelby Crawford earned this award by giving generously of her  
32 time and energy by raising over one thousand one hundred dollars (\$1,100) for  
33 a local horse rescue center, Tiny Timbers Horse Rescue, which cares for  
34 abused and neglected horses, and the money raised was used to buy two hundred  
35 fifty (250) bales of Bermuda hay for the horses at Tiny Timbers; and

2 other children experience contact with animals, and operating the zoo  
3 involved rounding up animals, borrowing equipment, organizing concessions,  
4 advertising throughout the community, and setting up pony rides and other  
5 displays and attractions; and

9 and leadership of young people like Miss Shelby Crawford who use their  
10 considerable talents and resources to serve others,
