23	WHEREAS, twenty-five percent (25%) of Arkansas' economy is based on
24	food, fiber, and forestry; and
25	
26	WHEREAS, two-thirds (2/3) of Arkansas' counties rely primarily on
27	farming and forestry as their industrial base; and
28	
29	WHEREAS, agriculture and related activities and industries employ one
30	(1) in four (4) Arkansans; and
31	
32	WHEREAS, agricultural pursuits in this state produce wealth in excess
33	of six billion dollars (\$6,000,000,000) annually and contribute immeasurably
34	to Arkansas' stable and well-balanced economy; and
35	
36	WHEREAS, farmers, ranchers, and foresters provide the bulk of the



1	state's wildlife habitat, practice sound environmental stewardship, and
2	supply community leadership throughout rural Arkansas; and
3	
4	WHEREAS, the agricultural community contributes a substantial portion
5	of the revenues which finance state and local services to all this state's
6	citizens; and
7	
8	WHEREAS, Arkansas farmers, ranchers and foresters are deserving of
9	public commendation and appreciation,
10	
11	NOW THEREFORE,
12	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTY-FOURTH GENERAL
13	ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

16	That the Arkansas House of Representatives hereby expresses sincere
17	appreciation to Arkansas farmers for their outstanding contributions to the
18	economy of the state and nation and to the well-being of the people, and
19	commends them for their dedication to the wise utilization of our resources
