23 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTY-FOURTH GENERAL
24 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

26 That the House Interim Committee on Public Health, Welfare, and Labor
27 is requested to conduct a study of the feasibility and desirability of
28 utilizing unused prescription drugs in long term care facilities for health
29 care for indigent persons.

31 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that to assist in the study, the committee is
32 requested to involve the Department of Human Services, the Department of
33 Health, the Arkansas Association of Area Agencies on Aging, the Arkansas
34 State Board of Nursing, the Arkansas State Board of Pharmacy, and other
35 entities and organizations which have expertise in the area.
