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21	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 27-72-314 is amended to read as follows:			
22	27-72-314. Disaster counties.			
23	(a)(l) It is the intent and purpose of this section to make available			
24	moneys in the State Aid Road Fund to the credit of disaster counties to be			
25	used to restore and repair county bridges or roads which are destroyed or			
26	which have suffered extensive damage as a result of tornadoes, heavy			
27	rainfall, or flooding conditions, or other natural disasters and to provide,			
28	together with county funds, the necessary matching moneys required to enable			
29	the disaster counties to obtain federal disaster relief funds for such			
30	projects.			
31	(2) Only (counties designated by the appro	priate federal or state	
32	official as disaster counties for public assistance shall be authorized to			
33	use moneys in the State Aid Road Fund under the matching provisions and for			
34	the purposes set forth in this section.			
35	(3) All other moneys deposited in the State Aid Road Fund shall			
36	be used solely on the matching basis and for the purposes set forth in §§ 27-			

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- 1 72-301, 27-72-305, 27-72-312, 27-72-313, and 27-72-315.
- 2 (b)(1) Notwithstanding the provisions of §§ 27-72-301, 27-72-305, 27-
- 3 72-312, 27-72-313, and 27-72-315, a county that has been determined by the
- 4 appropriate federal or state official as being a disaster county for public
- 5 assistance due to the tornadoes, excessive rainfall, and flooding conditions,
- 6 and other natural disasters shall be eligible to receive state aid road funds
- 7 credited to the account of the disaster county on a ninety percent (90%)
- 8 state aid road funds to not less than ten percent (10%) county matching fund
- 9 basis.
- 10 (2) Funds distributed to a disaster county under the special
- 11 matching provisions of this subsection shall be used solely for the
- 12 restoration or repair of county bridges or roads destroyed or which suffered
- 13 extensive damage as a result of tornadoes, heavy rainfall, or flooding
- 14 conditions, or other natural disasters, regardless of whether the roads or
- 15 bridges are a part of the state aid system of county roads.
- 16 (c) In addition to the uses provided for in subsection (b) of this
- 17 section, funds distributed to a disaster county under the matching provisions
- 18 of this section may be used to provide the necessary matching funds required
- 19 to match federal disaster relief funds available for the restoration or
- 20 repair of county bridges or roads which are destroyed or extensively damaged
- 21 as a result of tornadoes, heavy rainfall, or flooding conditions, or other
- 22 natural disasters, regardless of whether the roads or bridges are a part of
- 23 the state aid system of county roads.

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
