1 (b)(1)(A) The commissioners shall be appointed by the mayor, shall be 2 confirmed by a majority vote of the duly elected and qualified members of the 3 city council, and shall hold office for a term of five (5) years.

4 (B) However, the first commissioners to be appointed and 5 confirmed shall serve for terms of one (1), two (2), three (3), four (4), and 6 five (5) years, respectively, to be designated by the mayor and city council, 7 and thereafter, upon the expiration of their respective terms, commissioners 8 appointed by the mayor and approved by a majority vote of the city council 9 shall each be appointed for a term of five (5) years.

## (2) The commissioners may be reappointed.

11 (c)(1) In the event of a vacancy occurring on the commission, it shall 12 be filled by appointment by the mayor, subject to the approval of a majority 13 vote of the duly elected and qualified members of the city council.

(2) A vacancy shall be filled for the remainder of the term. 15 (d) Each commissioner shall file the oath required in the State of 16 Arkansas of public officials.

17 (e)(1) In the event the city council of any city votes to increase the 18 membership of its parks and recreation commission from five (5) to seven (7) 19 under subdivision (a)(2) of this section  $\frac{1}{1}$  members, then the  $\frac{1}{1}$  additional 20 members of the commission shall be appointed in the manner provided in 21 subsection (b) of this section and shall serve terms of five (5) years as 22 provided in subdivision (e)(4) of this section.
