1 SECTION 12. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRAINING 2 CONFERENCES. The funds appropriated herein for Aid to County Veterans Service 3 4 Offices may also be used by the Department of Veteran Affairs to pay expenses 5 of County Veterans Service Officers for attending regional or statewide 6 training conferences approved by the Department of Veterans Affairs and 7 designed to provide better trained and qualified Veterans Service Officers in 8 the various counties.
