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21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 12-15-202 is amended to read as follows:
24 12-15-202. Eligibility to carry concealed handgun.

25 (a) Any certified law enforcement officer may carry a concealed
26 handgun if that officer:

27 (1) Is presently in the employ of a public law enforcement
28 department, office, or agency; and

29 (2) Is authorized by the public law enforcement department,
30 office, or agency to carry a firearm in the course and scope of his or her
31 duties; and

32 (3) Is not subject to any disciplinary action by the public law
33 enforcement department, office, or agency; and

34 (4) Is carrying appropriate written identification issued by the
35 public law enforcement department, office, or agency identifying him or her
36 as a certified law enforcement officer; and



1 (5) Is not otherwise prohibited under ~~state or~~ federal law.

2 (b)(1) Any retired law enforcement officer may carry a concealed
3 handgun:

4 (A) Who retired from service with a public law enforcement
5 department, office, or agency for reasons other than mental disability;

6 (B) Who immediately before retirement was a certified law
7 enforcement officer authorized by a public law enforcement department,
8 office, or agency to carry a firearm in the course and scope of his or her
9 duties;

10 (C) Who has nonforfeitable rights to benefits under the
11 retirement plan of a public law enforcement department, office, or agency;

12 (D) Who is carrying appropriate written identification
13 issued by a public law enforcement department, office, or agency identifying
14 him or her as a retired and former certified law enforcement officer;

15 (E) Who is not otherwise prohibited under ~~state or~~ federal
16 law; and

17 (F) Whose fingerprint impressions are on file with the
18 Department of Arkansas State Police together with written authorization for
19 state and national level criminal history record screening.

20 (2) The chief law enforcement officer of the city or county
21 shall keep a record of all retired law enforcement officers authorized to
22 carry a concealed handgun in his jurisdiction and shall revoke any
23 authorization for good cause shown.

24 (c) Any certified law enforcement officer or retired law enforcement
25 officer carrying a concealed handgun under this section is not subject to the
26 prohibitions and limitations of § 5-73-306.

27 ~~(e)~~(d)(1) Any presently employed certified law enforcement officer
28 authorized by another state to carry a concealed handgun shall be entitled to
29 the same privilege while in this state, but subject to the same restrictions
30 of this section, provided that the state which has authorized the officer to
31 carry a concealed handgun extends the same privilege to presently employed
32 Arkansas-certified law enforcement officers.

33 (2) The Director of the Department of Arkansas State Police
34 shall make a determination as to which states extend the privilege to carry a
35 concealed handgun to presently employed Arkansas-certified law enforcement
36 officers and shall then determine which states' officers' authority to carry

1 concealed handguns will be recognized in Arkansas.

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
