SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP - MEDICAL BOARD. There is hereby authorized, for the Arkansas State Medical Board for the 2003-2005 biennium, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: one (1) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the appropriate classification.

SECTION 3. APPROPRIATIONS - MEDICAL BOARD. There is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas State Medical Board, to be payable from cash funds as defined by Arkansas Code 19-4-801 of the Arkansas State Medical Board, for personal services and operating expenses of the Arkansas State Medical Board for the biennial period ending June 30, 2005, the following:

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SECTION 4. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.

- 12 <u>EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS</u>. The State Medical Board is hereby authorized to expend
- 13 from monies authorized herein, no more than \$150,000 each fiscal year for
- 14 educational programs, either public or private, for impaired physicians with
- 15 alcohol or drug abuse problems. The provisions of this section shall be in
- 16 effect only from July 1, 2001 July 1, 2003 through June 30, 2003 June 30,
- 17 2005.

- 19 SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE
- 20 NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND BALANCES -
- 21 MEDICAL BOARD CASH FUND. (A) For all appropriations as provided in this Act,
- 22 the agency disbursing officer shall monitor the level of fund balances in
- 23 relation to expenditures on a monthly basis. If any proposed expenditures
- 24 would cause the Medical Board Cash Fund to decline below Four Hundred Ninety
- 25 One Thousand, Seven Hundred and Nine dollars (\$491,709) a fund balance to
- 26 decline to less than fifty percent (50%) of the balance available on July 1,
- 27 <del>2001</del>, the disbursing officer shall immediately notify the executive head of
- 28 the agency. Prior to any obligations being made under these circumstances,
- 29 the agency head shall file written documentation with the Chief Fiscal
- 30 Officer of the State requesting approval of the expenditures. Such
- 31 documentation shall provide sufficient financial data to justify the
- 32 expenditures and shall include the following:
- 33 1) a plan that clearly indicates the specific fiscal impact of such
- 34 expenditures on the fund balance.
- 35 2) information clearly indicating and explaining what programs would be cut
- 36 or any other measures to be taken by the agency to restore the fund balance.

1 3) the extent to which any of the planned expenditures are for one-time costs

- 2 or one-time purchase of capitalized items.
- 3 4) a statement certifying that the expenditure of fund balances will not
- 4 jeopardize the financial health of the agency, nor result in a permanent
- 5 depletion of the fund balance.
- 6 (B) The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall review the request and
- 7 approve or disapprove all or any part of the request, after having sought
- 8 prior review by the Legislative Council.
- 9 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2003
- 10 through June 30, 2005.

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- 12 SECTION 6. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
- 13 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
- 14 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
- 15 restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and
- 16 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
- 17 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
- 18 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
- 19 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
- 20 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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- 22 SECTION 7. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
- 23 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
- 24 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
- 25 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
- 26 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
- 27 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
- 28 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
- 29 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

- 31 SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
- 32 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
- 33 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
- 34 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2003 is essential to the operation of
- 35 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
- 36 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective

1	date of this Act beyond July 1, 2003 could work irreparable harm upon the
2	proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
3	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
4	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
5	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2003.
