9 AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL  
10 SERVICES AND OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE  
11 DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES - DIVISION OF  
12 CHILDREN AND FAMILY SERVICES FOR THE BIENNIAL  
13 PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 2005; AND FOR OTHER  
14 PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

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18 AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN  
19 SERVICES - DIVISION OF CHILDREN AND  
20 FAMILY SERVICES APPROPRIATION FOR THE  
21 2003-2005 BIENNIUM.  
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24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
25

26 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the  
27 Department of Human Services - Division of Children and Family Services for  
28 the 2003-2005 biennium, the following maximum number of regular employees  
29 whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform  
30 Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or  
31 its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any  
32 position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein in  
33 dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform Classification  
34 and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions authorized herein are  
35 hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and  
36 Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

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16 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the Department of  
 17 Human Services - Division of Children and Family Services for the 2003-2005  
 18 biennium, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees,  
 19 to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such  
 20 purposes: sixty-five (65) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at  
 21 rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and  
 22 Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the appropriate  
 23 classification.

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25 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to  
 26 the Department of Human Services - Division of Children and Family Services,  
 27 to be payable from the paying account as determined by the Chief Fiscal  
 28 Officer of the State, for personal services and operating expenses of the  
 29 Department of Human Services - Division of Children and Family Services for  
 30 the biennial period ending June 30, 2005, the following:

24 SECTION 5. APPROPRIATION - TANF/FOSTER CARE. There is hereby appropriated,  
 25 to the Department of Human Services - Division of Children and Family  
 26 Services, to be payable from the paying account as determined by the Chief  
 27 Fiscal Officer of the State, for grant payments of the Department of Human  
 28 Services - Division of Children and Family Services - TANF/Foster Care for  
 29 the biennial period ending June 30, 2005, the following:

36 SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

1 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CHILDREN  
 2 AND FAMILY SERVICES - SPECIAL RATES OF PAY. Due to current working  
 3 conditions and the necessity of recruiting and retaining qualified personnel,  
 4 the Division of Children and Family Services of the Department of Human  
 5 Services is authorized special rates of pay for current and new employees up  
 6 to the levels listed below:

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16 This special provision shall be in full force and effect for the biennium  
 17 beginning ~~July 1, 2001~~ July 1, 2003 and ending ~~June 30, 2003~~ June 30, 2005,  
 18 and shall be subject to a prior review by the Personnel Subcommittee of the  
 19 Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee.

20 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from ~~July 1, 2001~~  
 21 July 1, 2003 through ~~June 30, 2003~~ June 30, 2005.

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23 SECTION 7. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized  
 24 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds  
 25 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the  
 26 restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and  
 27 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
 28 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal  
 29 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by  
 30 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
 31 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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33 SECTION 8. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly  
 34 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained  
 35 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act  
 36 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations

1 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by  
2 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral  
3 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or  
4 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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6 SECTION 9. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General  
7 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the  
8 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the  
9 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2003 is essential to the operation of  
10 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
11 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective  
12 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2003 could work irreparable harm upon the  
13 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.  
14 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being  
15 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and  
16 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2003.
