13 ENDING JUNE 30, 2005; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

17 AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION
18 - ARKANSAS SCHOOL FOR MATHEMATICS AND
19 SCIENCES APPROPRIATION FOR THE 2003-2005
20 BIENNIUM.

23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
24

25 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the
26 Department of Education - Arkansas School for Mathematics and Sciences for
27 the 2003-2005 biennium, the following maximum number of regular employees
28 whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform
29 Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or
30 its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any
31 position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein in
32 dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform Classification
33 and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions authorized herein are
34 hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and
35 Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

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SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the Department of Education - Arkansas School for Mathematics and Sciences for the 2003-2005

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1 biennium, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees,
 2 to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such
 3 purposes: five (5) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates
 4 of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and
 5 Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the appropriate
 6 classification.

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 8 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department
 9 of Education, to be payable from the Department of Education Public School
 10 Fund Account, for personal services and operating expenses of the Department
 11 of Education - School for Mathematics and Sciences for the biennial period
 12 ending June 30, 2005, the following:

 27 SECTION 4. REGULAR SALARIES - DISTANCE LEARNING PROGRAM - CASH. There is
 28 hereby established for the Department of Education - School for Mathematics
 29 and Sciences - Distance Learning Program for the 2003-2005 biennium, the
 30 following maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be
 31 governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act
 32 (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory
 33 thereto. Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum
 34 annual salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the
 35 provisions of said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons
 36 occupying positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions

1 of the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-
2 101), or its successor.

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11 SECTION 5. APPROPRIATION - DISTANCE LEARNING PROGRAM - CASH. There is
12 hereby appropriated, to the Department of Education, to be payable from the
13 cash fund deposited in the State Treasury as determined by the Chief Fiscal
14 Officer of the State, for personal services and operating expenses of the
15 Department of Education - School for Mathematics and Sciences - Distance
16 Learning Program for the biennial period ending June 30, 2005, the following:

30 SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
31 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SUMMER
32 SCHOOL EMPLOYEES. Employees who, in addition to working during the regular
33 school term also work during the summer months, shall be authorized as
34 additional compensation an amount not to exceed 1/12 of their annual salary
35 for each month or part thereof worked. Such additional compensation shall
36 not be construed as exceeding the maximum salary authorized for said

1 employees. Payment of additional compensation shall be limited to employees
2 in the following classifications:

9 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from ~~July 1, 2001~~
10 July 1, 2003 through ~~June 30, 2003~~ June 30, 2005.

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12 *SECTION 7. APPROPRIATION. GENERAL IMPROVEMENT - ARKANSAS SCHOOL FOR*
13 *MATHEMATICS AND SCIENCES. There is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas*
14 *School for Mathematics and Sciences, to be payable from the General*
15 *Improvement Fund, or its successor fund or fund accounts, for costs*
16 *associated with construction, renovation, major maintenance, and purchase,*
17 *upgrade and installation of equipment, for each fiscal year of the biennial*
18 *period ending June 30, 2005, the sum of \$250,000.*

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20 *SECTION 8. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS*
21 *CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TEACHER*
22 *GRANT RELATED FUNDING PROVISION. Teachers of the School for Mathematics and*
23 *Sciences who, in addition to fulfilling annual teaching contract requirements*
24 *also write grants, grant progress reports and write and publish papers may be*
25 *authorized as additional annual compensation an amount up to 1/12 of their*
26 *annual salary. Such additional compensation shall not be construed as*
27 *exceeding the maximum salary authorized for said employees. The additional*
28 *compensation authorized by this section shall only be paid from a portion of*
29 *the grant monies received and shall not be paid from state general revenues*
30 *or Educational Excellence Trust Fund monies.*

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32 *SECTION 9. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized*
33 *by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds*
34 *made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the*
35 *restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and*
36 *Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary*

1 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
2 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
3 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
4 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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6 SECTION 10. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
7 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
8 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
9 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
10 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
11 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
12 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
13 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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15 SECTION 11. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
16 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
17 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
18 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2003 is essential to the operation of
19 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
20 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
21 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2003 could work irreparable harm upon the
22 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
23 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
24 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
25 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2003.
