22	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 17-82-304(b), concerning the licensing	
23	procedure for dentists, is amended to read as follows:

15	SECTION 3. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
16	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that a need exists to examine the
17	impact and quality of services to be performed by foreign-trained dentists
18	immigrating to Arkansas. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and
19	this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public
20	peace, health, and safety shall become effective on:
21	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;
22	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,
23	the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the
24	<u>bill; or</u>
25	(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is
26	overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
