Further, the General Assembly 4 5 has determined that the Arkansas State Building Services may operate more 6 efficiently if some flexibility is provided to the Arkansas State Building 7 Services authorizing broad powers under this section. Therefore, it is both 8 necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight by 9 requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee as provided by this section. The requirement of approval by the Legislative 10 11 Council or Joint Budget Committee is not a severable part of this section. 12 If the requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is ruled unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, 13 14 this entire section is void. 15 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2003 16 through June 30, 2005. 17 18 SECTION 15. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

2	SECTION 17. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
3	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
4	appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
5	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2003 is essential to the operation of
6	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
7	the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
8	date of this Act beyond July 1, 2003 could work irreparable harm upon the
9	proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
10	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
11	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
