11 SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. (ii) The 12 next three hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$350,000) or so much thereof as 13 14 may be collected in severance taxes, penalties, and costs on timber and 15 timber products, over and above the amount distributed to the State Forestry 16 Fund during each fiscal year as provided in subdivision (b)(2)(A)(i) of this section, shall be distributed and credited to the University of Arkansas at 17 18 Monticello Fund. The University of Arkansas at Monticello may transfer from 19 General Revenue to cash funds any timber severance tax funds as provided in Arkansas Code 26-58-124 subdivision (b)(2)(A)(ii), to be set aside therein to 20 21 be used solely and exclusively for providing additional support for the 22 School of Forestry of the University of Arkansas at Monticello, as per the 23 intent of Arkansas Code 26-58-124 subdivision (b)(2)(A)(ii); and 24 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2001 25 July 1, 2003 through June 30, 2003 June 30, 2005.

SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 27 28 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND 29 BALANCES. The Board of Trustees in its official governing capacity charged 30 with the management or control of the institution of higher learning and the 31 President or Chancellor as the Chief Executive shall certify to the Chief 32 Fiscal Officer of the State and the Legislative Council that as of December 33 31 of each year that sufficient appropriations and funds are available, or will become available, to meet all current and anticipated obligations during 34 35 the fiscal year for the payment of the obligations when they become due. 36 This certification, signed by the Chair of the Board of Trustees and the

President or Chancellor will be forwarded by February 28 of each year or upon
release of the previous year's audit by Legislative Audit to the Chief Fiscal
Officer of the State and the Legislative Council accompanied by the Board
approved published annual financial statement for the preceding fiscal year.
<u>The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2003</u>
through June 30, 2005.

8 SECTION 7. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized 9 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the 10 11 restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and 12 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditures 13 Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this 14 15 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of 16 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied 17 with in disbursement of said funds.

SECTION 8. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 19 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 20 21 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 22 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 23 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by 24 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 25 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or 26 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

28 SECTION 9. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General 29 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the 30 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2003 is essential to the operation of 31 32 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in 33 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2003 could work irreparable harm upon the 34 35 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being 36
