Employees being compensated at the maximum of their assigned grade shall be eligible for the six percent (6%) 18 increase in a lump sum payment, and such payment shall not be construed as 19 20 exceeding the maximum salary for the grade. 21 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2003 22 through June 30, 2005. 23 SECTION 12. LEGISLATIVE INTENT.
