SERVICES AND OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE ARKANSAS
STATE UNIVERSITY FOR THE BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING
JUNE 30, 2005; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

AN ACT FOR THE ARKANSAS STATE
UNIVERSITY APPROPRIATION FOR THE
2003-2005 BIENNIUM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - OPERATIONS. There is hereby established for the Arkansas State University for the 2003-2005 biennium, the following maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

8 SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
9 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.

10 REALLOCATION OF RESOURCES. Upon determination by the President of Arkansas
11 State University that a reallocation of resources for purposes of
12 reorganization or consolidation of administrative functions within the
13 university is necessary for efficient and effective operations of the
14 university, the president, with approval of the Arkansas State University
15 Board of Trustees, may have the authority to transfer positions,
16 appropriations and related funds between campuses, divisions, branches, and
17 other budgetary units of Arkansas State University. The transfers of
18 positions, programs, or activities shall be used for those purposes for which
19 the appropriations were approved by the General Assembly. The transfers,
20 consolidation, or reorganization which involve academic programs shall be
21 reviewed by the Department of Higher Education and the Legislative Council.

25 SECTION 7. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
26 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. LEASES.
27 Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, the Board of Trustees of Arkansas
28 State University may hereafter lease facilities or operations for room and
29 board purposes in any manner and upon terms the board deems to be in the best
30 interest of the university. Action taken under this act shall be by written
31 resolution adopted by at least a majority of the members of the board.

35 SECTION 8. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
36 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.

1 CONTINGENCY. (a) To address needs emerging from the restructuring of the
 2 Technical Institutes, ~~Delta ASU Technical Institute Center~~ shall establish
 3 and maintain for the ~~2001-2003~~ 2003-2005 biennium a pool of four (4)
 4 unclassified positions and three (3) classified positions, payable from funds
 5 appropriated for ~~Delta ASU Technical Institute Center~~. These positions are
 6 to be used by ~~Delta ASU Technical Institute Center~~ in the event that the
 7 number and level of positions available to address the needs emerging from
 8 business and industry driven program expansions exceeds the number of
 9 positions regularly authorized for ~~Delta ASU Technical Institute Center~~.

10 (b) ~~Delta ASU Technical Institute Center~~ shall provide justification to the
 11 Department of Finance and Administration's Office of Personnel Management
 12 (OPM) for the need to allocate titles from this position pool. No
 13 classifications will be assigned to the pool until such time as specific
 14 positions are requested and justified by ~~Delta ASU Technical Institute~~
 15 Center, recommended by OPM and approved by the Legislative Council. ~~Delta~~
 16 ASU Technical Institute Center may transfer positions from this pool to any
 17 pay schedule the agency currently maintains or any pay schedule the agency
 18 receives during the ~~2001-2003~~ 2003-2005 biennium.

19 (c) Determining the number of personnel to be employed by a state agency is
 20 the prerogative of the General Assembly and is usually accomplished by
 21 delineating the maximum number of personnel by identifying job titles and the
 22 maximum grade or salary attached to those titles. The General Assembly has
 23 determined that ~~Delta ASU Technical Institute Center~~ could be operated more
 24 efficiently if some flexibility is given to that agency. That flexibility is
 25 being accomplished by providing growth pools in subsection (a) of this
 26 section and since the General Assembly has granted the agency broad powers
 27 under the growth pool concept, it is both necessary and appropriate that the
 28 General Assembly maintain oversight of the utilization of the growth pool by
 29 requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council in the utilization of the
 30 growth pool. Therefore, the requirement of approval by the Legislative
 31 Council is not a severable part of this section. If the requirement of
 32 approval by the Legislative Council is ruled unconstitutional by a court of of
 33 competent jurisdiction, this entire section is void.

34 If the agency requests continuation of a "Growth Pool" position(s) as
 35 established herein during the next biennium, the position(s) must be
 36 requested as a new position(s) in the agencies biennial budget request.

1 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from ~~July 1, 2001~~ July

4 SECTION 9. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
5 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. PART-TIME
6 FACULTY - ~~DELTA ASU TECHNICAL INSTITUTE CENTER~~. The Technical ~~Institutes~~
7 Centers are not required to remit a state contribution to the state employee
8 insurance trust fund on Workforce Education Part-time Faculty Positions
9 unless the position will be utilized for more than 1,000 hours a year.

10 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from ~~July 1, 2001~~
11 July 1, 2003 through ~~June 30, 2003~~ June 30, 2005.

12
13 SECTION 10. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
14 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND
15 BALANCES. The Board of Trustees in its official governing capacity charged
16 with the management or control of the institution of higher learning and the
17 President or Chancellor as the Chief Executive shall certify to the Chief
18 Fiscal Officer of the State and the Legislative Council that as of December
19 31 of each year that sufficient appropriations and funds are available, or
20 will become available, to meet all current and anticipated obligations during
21 the fiscal year for the payment of the obligations when they become due.
22 This certification, signed by the Chair of the Board of Trustees and the
23 President or Chancellor will be forwarded by February 28 of each year or upon
24 release of the previous year's audit by Legislative Audit to the Chief Fiscal
25 Officer of the State and the Legislative Council accompanied by the Board
26 approved published annual financial statement for the preceding fiscal year.

27 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2003
28 through June 30, 2005.

29
30 SECTION 11. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
31 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
32 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
33 restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and
34 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
35 Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditures
36 Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this

1 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of
2 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied
3 with in disbursement of said funds.
4

5 SECTION 12. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
6 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
7 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
8 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
9 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
10 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
11 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
12 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
13

14 SECTION 13. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
15 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
16 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
17 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2003 is essential to the operation of
18 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
19 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
20 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2003 could work irreparable harm upon the
21 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
22 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
23 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
24 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2003.
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
