If any proposed expenditures would cause the Livestock and Poultry 16 Commission Disease and Pest Control Fund to decline below two hundred forty 17 three thousand ninety six dollars (\$243,096) a fund balance to decline to less than fifty percent (50%) of the balance available on July 1, 2001, the 18 19 disbursing officer shall immediately notify the executive head of the agency. 20 Prior to any obligations being made under these circumstances, the agency 21 head shall file written documentation with the Chief Fiscal Officer of the 22 State requesting approval of the expenditures. SECTION 31. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. 23 SECTION 33. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General 24 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the 25 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the 26 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2003 is essential to the operation of 27 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in 28 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective 29 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2003 could work irreparable harm upon the 30 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. 31 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being 32 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and 33 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2003. 34 35 */s/ Joint Budget Committee*
