9	SECTION 3. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the		
10	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the financial well being of		
11	self-insured employers in this state is unduly burdened by the requirement to		
12	obtain excess insurance; and that this act is immediately necessary to		
13	relieve that burden. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this
