2 DISBURSEMENT OF FUNDS. No monies collected by the Arkansas State Board of 3 Physical Therapy or funds authorized by this Act, shall be disbursed except 4 by a member of the State Board of Physical Therapy designated as the Board's 5 Disbursing Officer.

7 SECTION 5. EMPLOYMENT OF ATTORNEYS. None of the funds appropriated in 8 this Act for Maintenance and General Operation shall be expended in payment 9 for services of attorneys, unless the agency shall first make a request in 10 writing to the Attorney General of the State of Arkansas to provide the 11 required legal services. The Attorney General's Office shall provide the 12 requested legal services, or, if the Attorney General's Office shall 13 determine that sufficient personnel are not available to provide the 14 requested legal services, the Attorney General shall certify the same to the 15 agency and may authorize the agency to employ legal counsel and to expend 16 monies appropriated for Maintenance and General Operations therefor, if:

17 (1) The Attorney General determines, and certifies in writing, that such18 agency needs the advice or assistance of legal counsel, and

19 (2) The Attorney General consents in writing to the employment of the 20 legal counsel to be retained by the agency.

Such certification shall be required with respect to each instance of the employment of special legal counsel, or shall be required annually with respect to legal counsel employed on a retainer basis. A copy of such certification shall be entered in the official minutes of the agency, and shall be retained in the fiscal records of the agency for audit purposes.

SECTION 6. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized 27 28 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds 29 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the 30 restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and 31 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 32 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 33 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 34 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 35 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

1 SECTION 7. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 2 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 3 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 4 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 5 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by 6 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or 7 8 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 9

10 SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General

11 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the

12 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the

13 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2003 is essential to the operation of

14 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in

15 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective

16 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2003 could work irreparable harm upon the

17 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.

18 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being

19 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
