# A Bill

SENATE BILL 69

## For An Act To Be Entitled

9 AN ACT TO PROVIDE AN EXEMPTION TO THE CONCEALED  
10 HANDGUN LICENSE LAW FOR MILITARY PERSONNEL; TO  
11 PROVIDE FOR TRANSFERRING CONCEALED HANDGUN  
12 LICENSES FROM RECIPROCAL STATES; AND FOR OTHER  
13 PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

16 TO PROVIDE AN EXEMPTION TO THE CONCEALED  
17 HANDGUN LICENSE LAW FOR MILITARY  
18 PERSONNEL; TO PROVIDE FOR TRANSFERRING  
19 CONCEALED HANDGUN LICENSES FROM  
20 RECIPROCAL STATES.

23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

24  
25 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 5-73-309(1)(A), concerning requirements for  
26 a concealed handgun license, is amended to read as follows:

27 (1)(A)(i) Is a resident of the state and has been a resident  
28 continuously for twelve (12) months or longer immediately preceding the  
29 filing of the application.

30 (ii) Provided, this shall not apply to any retired  
31 city, county, state, or federal law enforcement officer or active duty  
32 military personnel who submit documentation of his or her active duty status;  
33

34 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 5-73-313, concerning expiration and renewal  
35 of a concealed handgun license, is amended to add an additional subsection to  
36 read as follows:



1       (g) Active duty military personnel and reservists on active duty who  
2 submit documentation of their active duty status shall be exempt from the  
3 training requirements under subsection (b) of this section.

5       SECTION 3. Arkansas Code Title 5, Chapter 73, Subchapter 3 is amended  
6 to add an additional section to read as follows:

7       5-73-319. Transfer of a license to Arkansas.

8       (a) Any person who has a valid license to carry a concealed handgun  
9 issued by a reciprocal state, who becomes a resident of Arkansas, may apply  
10 to transfer his or her license to Arkansas by submitting the following to the  
11 Department of Arkansas State Police:

12               (1) His or her current reciprocal state permit;

13               (2) Two (2) properly completed fingerprint cards;

14               (3) A nonrefundable license fee of thirty-five dollars (\$35.00);

15 and

16               (4) Any fees charged by state and federal agencies for a  
17 criminal history check.

18       (b) The newly transferred license shall be valid for a period of four  
19 (4) years from the date of issuance, and shall bind the holder to all  
20 Arkansas laws and regulations regarding the carrying of the concealed  
21 handgun.
