WHEREAS, state government faces chronic and severe shortages in available funds to meet the continual needs of its significant infrastructure investment with the dramatic drop in interest rates and the depletion of other available onetime revenue sources, NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS: SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 19-5-1005, pertaining to the General Improvement Fund, is amended by adding an additional subsection to read as follows: (3) The General Improvement Fund shall not be used for the financing of any appropriation enacted by the General Assembly for any nonstate related local or private project, program, or activity until it is determined by resolution of both houses of the Arkansas General Assembly that all necessary and appropriate infrastructure needs of the various state agencies, facilities, and programs have been provided for and that sufficient unobligated funds exist to prudently proceed with the financing of nonstate government related projects or programs.
