## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO CHANGE THE NAME OF THE ARKANSAS SCHOOL  
OF PUBLIC HEALTH TO THE COLLEGE OF PUBLIC HEALTH  
OF THE UNIVERSITY OF ARKANSAS FOR MEDICAL  
SCIENCES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

TO CHANGE THE NAME OF THE ARKANSAS  
SCHOOL OF PUBLIC HEALTH TO THE COLLEGE  
OF PUBLIC HEALTH OF THE UNIVERSITY OF  
ARKANSAS FOR MEDICAL SCIENCES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. The Arkansas School of Public Health, created by Arkansas  
Code § 19-12-114 as a part of the University of Arkansas for Medical  
Sciences, shall hereafter be known as the College of Public Health of the  
University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences.
