7	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 24-11-434(i), concerning the deferred
8	retirement option plan for police pension and relief funds, is repealed.
9	(i) Participants in the plan subject to the extended ten-year service
10	limit shall forfeit a portion of the extended service benefits earned,
11	specifically limited to only the interest and employer contributions'
12	portions which have been credited to the plan account, under the plan beyond
13	the first five (5) years of participation should the participant terminate
14	employment during the extended service time, absent death or disability, as
15	follows:
16	(1) Forfeit eighty percent (80%) if termination occurs in the
17	sixth year of participation;
18	(2) Forfeit sixty percent (60%) if termination occurs in the
19	seventh year of participation;
20	(3) Forfeit forty percent (40%) if termination occurs in the
21	eighth year of participation; and
22	(4) Forfeit twenty percent (20%) if termination occurs in the
23	ninth year of participation.
