7 SECTION 3. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the 8 General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the Arkansas Code contains 9 language that is obsolete; that other states with similar obsolete language have been forced to engage in legal matters relating to the oversight; and 10 11 that this act is immediately necessary because a delay in implementation would cause a disruption in the educational programs of this state and the 12 13 ability to provide certain agricultural related programs.
