SECTION 7. EMPLOYMENT OF ATTORNEYS. None of the funds appropriated in 18 19 this Act for Maintenance and General Operation shall be expended in payment 20 for services of attorneys, unless the agency shall first make a request in 21 writing to the Attorney General of the State of Arkansas to provide the 22 required legal services. The Attorney General's Office shall provide the 23 requested legal services, or, if the Attorney General's Office shall 24 determine that sufficient personnel are not available to provide the 25 requested legal services, the Attorney General shall certify the same to the 26 agency and may authorize the agency to employ legal counsel and to expend 27 monies appropriated for Maintenance and General Operations therefor, if: 28

(1) The Attorney General determines, and certifies in writing, that suchagency needs the advice or assistance of legal counsel, and

30 (2) The Attorney General consents in writing to the employment of the 31 legal counsel to be retained by the agency.

32 Such certification shall be required with respect to each instance of the 33 employment of special legal counsel, or shall be required annually with 34 respect to legal counsel employed on a retainer basis. A copy of such 35 certification shall be entered in the official minutes of the agency, and 36 shall be retained in the fiscal records of the agency for audit purposes.

SECTION 8. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized 2 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds 3 4 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the 5 restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and 6 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 7 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 8 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 9 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 10 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

12 SECTION 9. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 13 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 14 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 15 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 16 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by 17 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or 18 19 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 20

21 SECTION 10. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General 22 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the 23 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the 24 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2003 is essential to the operation of 25 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in 26 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective 27 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2003 could work irreparable harm upon the 28 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. 29 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being 30 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and 31 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2003. 32 33
