SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 27-37-707 is amended to read as follows: 27-37-707. Traffic violation report and driver license suspension. (a) The Office of Driver Services of the Revenue Division of the Department of Finance and Administration shall not include in the traffic violation report of any person any conviction arising out of a violation of this subchapter. (b) No violations under this subchapter shall be used or accumulated by the Office of Driver Services to suspend or revoke the driver license of any person as a habitual violator of traffic laws, or used in any other way under the administrative authority of the department to suspend or revoke licenses.
