20 WHEREAS, the Senate will complete its work of the first week of the
21 2003 General Assembly on Thursday, January 16, 2003; and

22 WHEREAS, Arkansas Code § 1-5-101 provides that the third Monday in
23 January is an official state holiday in honor of Dr. Martin Luther King,
24 Jr.'s birthday and Robert E. Lee's birthday; and

25 WHEREAS, Monday, January 20, 2003, is the third Monday in January of
26 2003; and

27 WHEREAS, Arkansas Code § 10-2-128 provides that in respect to Dr.
28 Martin Luther King, Jr. and in observation of his birthday, neither the House
29 of Representatives nor the Senate shall convene in session nor shall any of
30 their committees meet on the third Monday in January; and

31 WHEREAS, Section 28 of Article 5 of the Arkansas Constitution provides
32 that "Neither house shall, without the consent of the other, adjourn for more
33 than three days, nor to any other place than that in which the two houses
34 shall be sitting";
