22 manufacturing plants, and thirty-five retail brick and tile stores; and

25 in Arkansas and Tennessee, in which Acme Brick has seven retail stores and
26 distribution yards; and

30 United States and Canada; and

32 WHEREAS, Scotty joined Acme Brick at the company headquarters in Fort
33 Worth while attending Texas Christian University; and

35 WHEREAS, during 1961, Scotty was activated with the National Guard 49th
36 Armored Division and spent ten months at Fort Polk, Louisiana during the
