WHEREAS, a Mallard soaring above the water with trees in the background symbolizes Arkansas' abundant natural resources and its reputation as one of the top states in the country for hunting and fishing; and

WHEREAS, the stalks of rice honor our State's agricultural heritage,
and allude to the fact that Arkansas is the leading rice producer in the country; and

WHEREAS, a key element at the center of the design is a diamond alluding to the Crater of Diamonds at Murfreesboro which is the eighth largest known diamond deposit in the world, and the site where the largest diamond ever unearthed in the United States was found; and

WHEREAS, the Arkansas quarter will be released in October 2003, and it will be the twenty-fifth state quarter to be released; and

WHEREAS, the Arkansas quarter will be in circulation for at least thirty years, and will be treasured by coin collectors worldwide, NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE EIGHTY-FOURTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:
