NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE EIGHTY-FOURTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN: THAT the Joint Committee on Advanced Communications and Information Technology should meet as soon as possible with telecommunications connectivity providers, such as Southwestern Bell and Alltel, to determine the status of distance learning programs in Arkansas, including current technological capability and usage. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the Joint Committee on Advanced Communications and Information Technology should meet as soon as possible with telecommunications connectivity providers to pursue distance learning as a supplemental means of educational reform to reduce or eliminate the need to consolidate Arkansas' school districts.
