7	SECTION 2. Section 17 of Article 5 of the Constitution of the State of
8	Arkansas is amended to read as follows:
9	§ 17. Duration of sessions.
10	The regular biennial annual sessions shall not exceed sixty days in
11	duration, unless by a vote of two-thirds of the members elected to each house
12	of $\frac{1}{2}$ General Assembly. Provided, that this section shall not apply $\frac{1}{2}$
13	the first session of the General Assembly under this Constitution, or when
14	impeachments are pending.

16	SECTION 3. This amendment becomes effective January 1, 2005.
