20	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE EIGHTY-FOURTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE
21	STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23	That the Senate Interim Committee on Education is requested to conduct
24	a study of the Arkansas Academic Challenge Scholarship Program and review:
25	(1) The number of students for the last five (5) fiscal years who
26	received Arkansas Academic Challenge Scholarships;
27	(2) The institutions of higher education in Arkansas where the
28	students attended for the five-year period;
29	(3) The average amount of additional scholarship or grant money
30	awarded to those students who received Arkansas Academic Challenge
31	Scholarships from each institution of higher education for the five-year
32	period;
33	(4) The amount of state and federal scholarship funds received by
34	students at each institution of higher education for the five-year period;
35	(5) Such other information, as may be determined by the interim
36	committees as relevant to:



(A) A review of the Arkansas Academic Challenge Scholarship Program to determine if the overall educational needs of Arkansas students are being served through existing scholarship programs, as implemented, and together with any federal and state aid programs for students of higher education; and (B) Determine if existing programs are being carried out and implemented in the most efficient, economical manner, not only for the students, but also, the taxpayers of the State of Arkansas. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that to assist in the study, the Department of Higher Education is authorized and directed to gather and compile the information as may be requested by the interim committees to carry out the study. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the committee draft appropriate legislation for presentation to the 2005 Regular Session of the Arkansas General Assembly.
