26 Prudential Spirit of Community Award for collecting over one thousand five
27 hundred (1,500) blankets, one thousand five hundred (1,500) cooking utensils
28 and four hundred (400) sets of dishes for elderly, sick, and needy people in
29 southern Arkansas; and

31 WHEREAS, Shelby Crawford, 11, of Eureka Springs, Arkansas, was awarded
32 the 2003 Prudential Spirit of Community Award for raising one thousand one
33 hundred dollars (\$1,100) for a local horse rescue center; and

36 Prudential Distinguished Finalist for teaching all terrain vehicle safety

4 Prudential Distinguished Finalist for developing and coordinating a Teen
5 Court program for the Faulkner County Court System; and

8 recognized as a Prudential Distinguished Finalist for repairing and
9 refurbishing a local elementary school playground; and

11 WHEREAS, Crystal Whisenhunt, 15, of Langley, Arkansas, was recognized
12 as a Prudential Distinguished Finalist for collecting nearly three hundred
13 (300) coats for needy children and adults in her community,
