31	(2) Require schools to include as part of the annual report to
32	parents and the community the amounts and specific sources of funds received
33	and expenditures made from competitive food and beverage contracts:
34	(3) Require schools to include as a part of $\frac{1}{2}$ student $\frac{1}{2}$
35	report <del>card</del> to parents an annual body mass index percentile by age for each
36	students;
