## For An Act To Be Entitled

9 AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL  
10 SERVICES AND OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE  
11 DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH - MARINE SANITATION PROGRAM  
12 FOR THE BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 2005; AND  
13 FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

16 AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH -  
17 MARINE SANITATION PROGRAM APPROPRIATION  
18 FOR THE 2003-2005 BIENNIUM.  
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20  
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22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
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24 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - MARINE SANITATION PROGRAM. There is hereby  
25 appropriated, to the Department of Health, to be payable from the Marine  
26 Sanitation Fund, for personal services, operating expenses and other costs  
27 associated with the implementation of a marine sanitation program by the  
28 Department of Health for each year of the biennial period ending June 30,  
29 2005, the sum of .....\$300,000.  
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31 SECTION 2. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized  
32 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds  
33 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the  
34 restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and  
35 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
36 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal



1 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by  
 2 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
 3 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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 5 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly  
 6 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained  
 7 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act  
 8 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations  
 9 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by  
 10 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral  
 11 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or  
 12 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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 14 SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General  
 15 Assembly, that the effectiveness of this Act is essential to the operation of  
 16 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided and that in  
 17 the event of an extension of the Extraordinary Session, the delay in the  
 18 effective date of this Act could work irreparable harm upon the proper  
 19 administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore,  
 20 an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the  
 21 immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall become  
 22 effective:

23 (1) On the date of its approval by the Governor;

24 (2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, the  
 25 expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the bill;  
 26 or

27 (3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is overridden, the  
 28 date the last house overrides the veto.
