1	SECTION 6. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General	
2	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the	
3	appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the	
4	establishment of two-way interactive television for distance learning	
5	education is an educationally and cost effective approach to distance	
6	learning in Arkansas' small schools; that the effectiveness of this Act on	
7	the date of its passage and approval is essential to the operation of the	
8	agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the	
9	event of an extension of the Second Extraordinary Session of 2003, the delay	
10	in the effective date of this Act beyond the date of its passage and approval	
11	$\underline{\text{could}}$ work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of	
12	essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared	
13	to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the	
14	public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and	
15	after the date of its passage and approval.	
16	If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become	
17	effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor	
18	may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is	
19	overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house overrides	
20	the veto.
