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24	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:	
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26	SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - HOUSE EXPENSES. There is hereby appropriated,	
27	to the Arkansas House of Representatives, to be payable from the	
28	Constitutional Officers Fund, for necessary expenses of the Arkansas House of	
29	Representatives for the fiscal year ending	June 30, 2005, the following:

1 2 SECTION 2. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 3 4 TRANSFERS. If the Speaker of the House and the Coordinator of House 5 Legislative Services determine that any item or portion thereof appropriated 6 herein for a specific purpose is not needed for such purposes, they may 7 certify such fact to the State Auditor, and the State Auditor shall cause 8 transfer to be made from one item to another. 9 10 SECTION 3. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 11 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. USES OF 12 APPROPRIATION. The funds appropriated in this Act shall be used to defray the expenses of the House of Representatives of the Regular Session of the 13 14 Eighty fourth Eighty-fifth General Assembly, and upon adjournment of the 15 Regular Session, any unexpended balance of the funds appropriated in this Act 16 may be used to defray the necessary expenses of the operation of the Office 17 of the Speaker of the House of Representatives, the Office of the Coordinator of House Legislative Services, the Office of Parliamentarian, the Chief 18 19 Clerk's Office, House Constituency Services Office and other reasonable and 20 necessary expenses of the House of Representatives of the Eighty fourth 21 Eighty-fifth General Assembly incurred during the interim between the 22 adjournment of the Regular Session of the Eighty-fourth Eighty-fifth General 23 Assembly and July 1, 2003 July 1, 2005. 24 Additionally, if it is determined by the Speaker of the House that the 25 presence, assistance, oversight and expertise of any House member is needed 26 in the interim between the regular sessions, and if it is determined by the 27 Speaker of the House that certain expenses and per diem of members of the 28 House should be paid by the House, such expenses and per diem at the rate 29 authorized for attending legislative sessions shall be paid from the funds 30 appropriated herein for Maintenance, Operations and Expenses. 31 32 SECTION 4. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 33 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SALARY 34 LEVELS. The Speaker of the House of Representatives and the Coordinator of 35 House Legislative Services shall, during the month of June, 2003 and 2004

2005 and 2006, meet and determine the actual salaries to be paid each

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1 employee beginning the following July 1. Such salaries of the employees will 2 be based upon an evaluation of the performance of the Coordinator of House Legislative Services by the Speaker of the House of Representatives and upon 3 4 an evaluation of the performance of the other employees by the Coordinator of 5 House Legislative Services. The Parliamentarian of the House of 6 Representatives may be paid a per diem up to such amount as is authorized for 7 members of the General Assembly each day the General Assembly is in regular 8 or extraordinary session. The Coordinator of House Legislative Services and 9 the Parliamentarian may be provided an expense allowance up to such amount as 10 is authorized for reimbursable expenses for members of the General Assembly. 11 Such per diem shall be paid from the appropriation provided in Section 1 of 12 this Act. The expense allowance and associated personal services matching 13 costs, if any, are to be paid from the appropriations for Personal Services 14 provided in the biennial appropriation act for personal services and 15 operating expenses for the Arkansas House of Representatives for the 16 applicable fiscal year. 17 18 SECTION 5. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly, that the House of Representatives of the 85th General Assembly 19 20 convenes in regular session on January 10, 2005; that expenses of the session 21 begin immediately; and that the expenses are a just expense of state which must be paid at the time the services are provided. Therefore, an emergency 22 23 is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force 24 25 and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval. If the bill 26 is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become effective on 27 the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the 28 bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is overridden, it 29 shall become effective on the date the last house overrides the veto. 30 31 32 33 34 35

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
