21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 18-60-304 is amended to read as follows:  
24 18-60-304. Actions constituting unlawful detainer.

25 A person shall be guilty of an unlawful detainer within the meaning of  
26 this subchapter if the person shall, willfully and without right:

27 (1) Hold over any lands, tenements, or possessions after the  
28 determination of the time for which they were demised or let to him or her,  
29 or the person under whom he or she claims;

30 (2) Peaceably and lawfully obtain possession of any such  
31 property and hold it willfully and unlawfully after demand made in writing  
32 for the delivery or surrender of possession thereof by the person having the  
33 right to possession, his or her agent or attorney; ~~or~~

34 (3) Fail or refuse to pay the rent therefor when due, and after  
35 three (3) days' notice to quit and demand made in writing for the possession  
36 thereof by the person entitled thereto, his or her agent or attorney, shall



1 refuse to quit possession;

2 (4) Fail to maintain the premises in a safe, healthy, or  
3 habitable condition; or

4 (5) Cause or permit the premises to become:

5 (A) A public or private nuisance; or

6 (B) A common nuisance subject to abatement under § 14-54-  
7 1501 et seq.; The Arkansas Drug Abatement Act of 1989, § 16-105-401 et seq.;  
8 or any other law of this state.
