    (A) The supervision and maintenance of order in the
courtroom;
    (B) Providing security for the judge, officers of the
court, and other individuals involved in court proceedings;
            (C) Administering oaths; and
            (D) Other related duties as assigned by the judge.
            (2)(A) The bailiff may have and maintain law enforcement
certification, but certification is not required.
            (B) A bailiff who does not maintain law enforcement
certification may not carry firearms or take any other official law enforcing
