2	(1) "Abortion" shall mean the intentional termination of the	
3	pregnancy of a woman known to be pregnant with an intention other than to	
4	increase the probability of a live birth or to remove a dead or dying fetus;	
5	(2) "Minor" means an individual under the age of eighteen (18)	
6	years;	
7	(3) "Parent" shall mean <del>both parents</del> either parent of the	
8	pregnant woman if they are both living; one (1) parent of the pregnant woman	
9	if only one (1) is living or if the second one (1) cannot be located through	
10	reasonably diligent effort; or the court-appointed guardian or custodian if	
11	the pregnant woman has one; and	
12	(4) "Unemancipated minor" means a minor who is under the care,	
13	custody, and control of her parent or parents.	
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15	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 20-16-803 is amended to read as follows:

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13	SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 20-16-804 is amended to read as follows:	
14	20-16-804. Judicial relief from requirement.	
15	Notwithstanding the provisions of $\$\$$ 20-16-801 and 20-16-803, if a	
16	pregnant minor or incompetent woman elects not to allow the notification and	
17	consent of one (1) or both parents or guardian or custodian, then, in that	
18	event:	
19	(1)(A) Any judge of a probate court shall, upon petition or	
20	motion and after an appropriate hearing, authorize a physician to perform the	
21	abortion if $\frac{1}{2}$ the judge determines that the pregnant minor or incompetent	
22	woman is mature and capable of giving informed consent to the proposed	
23	abortion.	
24	(B) If <del>said</del> <u>the</u> judge determines that the pregnant minor	
25	or incompetent woman is not mature, or if the pregnant woman does not claim	
26	to be mature, the judge shall determine whether the performance of an	
27	abortion upon her without notification and consent of her parents, guardian,	
28	or custodian would be in her best interests and shall authorize a physician

12	20-16-808. When notification and consent of parent not required.
13	Notification and consent under this subchapter shall not be required to
14	be given to or obtained from a parent if:
15	(1) The parent's Both of the parents' whereabouts are unknown;
16	<u>or</u>
17	(2) (A) The parent has not been in contact with the minor's
18	custodial parent or the minor for at least one (1) year; or If the minor has
19	only one (1) living parent and the minor states by affidavit that the parent
20	has committed incest with the minor, has raped the minor, or has otherwise
21	sexually abused the minor.
22	(B) The attending physician shall report the abuse as

2	(a) In addition to other information reported by an abortion provider
3	to the Department of Health, the following information shall be reported for
4	each induced termination of pregnancy:
5	(1) Whether parental consent was required;

7	(3) Whether a judicial bypass was obtained.

9	abortion providers to report an induced termination of pregnancy by including
10	the reporting of information required by this section.
