22	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL	ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARK	ANSAS:
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24	SECTION 1. APPROPRIATIONS - WIC - FOOD INSTRUMENTS. There is hereby		
25	appropriated, to the Department of Health, to be payable from cash funds as		
26	defined by Arkansas Code 19-4-801 of the Department of Health, for Women,		
27	Infants and Children's (WIC) Food Instruments of the Department of Health		
28	which shall be supplemental and in addition to those funds appropriated in		
29	Section 17 of Act 33 of the First Extraordinary Session of 2003, the

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36	SECTION 2. COMPLIANCE WIT	H OTHER LAWS. Disbursement o	f funds authorized

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1 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds 2 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the 3 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 4 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 5 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 6 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 7 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 8 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds. 9 10 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 11 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 12 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 13 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 14 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by 15 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 16 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or 17 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 18 SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General 19 20 Assembly, that funds provided by the General Assembly for the operations of 21 the Department of Health are, due to unforeseen circumstances, insufficient 22 for the Department of Health to continue to provide essential governmental 23 services; that the provisions of this act will provide the necessary monies for the Department of Health to continue such services; and that a delay in 24 25 the effective date of this Act could work irreparable harm upon the proper 26 administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, 27 an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the 28 immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in 29 full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval. 30 If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor 31 may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is 32 33 overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house overrides 34 the veto.

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
