5	SECTION 4. EMPLOYMENT OF ATTORNEYS. None	e of the funds a	ppropriated in			
6	this Act for Maintenance and General Operat	ion shall be exp	ended in payment			
7	for services of attorneys, unless the agency	y shall first ma	ike a request in			
8	writing to the Attorney General of the State of Arkansas to provide the					
9	required legal services. The Attorney General's Office shall provide the					
10	requested legal services, or, if the Attorney General's Office shall					
11	determine that sufficient personnel are not available to provide the					
12	requested legal services, the Attorney General shall certify the same to the					
13	agency and may authorize the agency to employ legal counsel and to expend					
14	monies appropriated for Maintenance and General Operations therefor, if:					
15	(1) The Attorney General determines, and certifies in writing, that such					
16	agency needs the advice or assistance of legal counsel, and					
17	(2) The Attorney General consents in writing to the employment of the					
18	legal counsel to be retained by the agency.					
19	Such certification shall be required with respect to each instance of the

29	(A) For all appropriations as provided in	this Act, the ag	ency disbursing			
30	officer shall monitor the level of fund bala	ances in relatio	on to expenditures

32	Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors Board cash fund deposited in the

- 9 3) the extent to which any of the planned expenditures are for one-time costs
- 10 or one-time purchase of capitalized items.
- 11 4) a statement certifying that the expenditure of fund balances will not
- 12 jeopardize the financial health of the agency, nor result in a permanent
- 13 depletion of the fund balance.
- 14 (B) The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall review the request and
- 15 approve or disapprove all or any part of the request, after having sought
- 16 prior review by the Legislative Council.
- 17 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2003
- 18 2005 through June 30, 2005 2007.

- 20 SECTION 6. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
- 21 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
- 22 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
- 23 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
- 24 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
- 25 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
- 26 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
- 27 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
- 28 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

- 30 SECTION 7. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
- 31 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
- 32 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
- 33 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
- 34 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
- 35 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
- 36 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or

1	Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
2	
3	SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
4	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
5	appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
6	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2005 is essential to the operation of
7	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
8	the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
9	date of this Act beyond July 1, 2005 could work irreparable harm upon the
10	proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
11	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
12	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
13	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2005.
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
