## For An Act To Be Entitled

9 AN ACT TO ALLOW A PRIVATE DRIVER TRAINING  
10 FACILITY OR OTHER FACILITY TO ADMINISTER THE  
11 SKILLS TEST REQUIRED TO OBTAIN A COMMERCIAL  
12 DRIVER LICENSE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

15 AN ACT TO ALLOW A PRIVATE DRIVER  
16 TRAINING FACILITY OR OTHER FACILITY TO  
17 ADMINISTER THE SKILLS TEST REQUIRED TO  
18 OBTAIN A COMMERCIAL DRIVER LICENSE.

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
22

23 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 27-23-108(a)(2), concerning commercial  
24 driver license qualification standards, is amended to read as follows:

25 (2) The Department of Arkansas State Police shall, by  
26 regulations issued no later than thirty (30) days after the effective date of  
27 this subdivision (a)(2), authorize a person, including an agency of this or  
28 another state, an employer, a private driver training facility, other private  
29 institution, or a department, agency, or instrumentality of local government,  
30 to administer the skills test specified by this section. These third party  
31 testing regulations shall provide as a minimum that:

32 (i) The test is the same which would otherwise be  
33 administered by the state;

34 (ii) The third party shall enter into an agreement  
35 with the state which complies with requirements of 49 C.F.R., part 383.75;

36 (iii) The Department of Arkansas State Police shall



1 designate and provide to any third party testers the evidence to be used to  
2 indicate to the state licensing agency that an applicant had successfully  
3 passed the skills test;

4 (iv) The eligibility to become a third party tester  
5 shall be open to qualified persons under the regulations at least twice  
6 annually; and

7 (v) The third party tester shall pay a third party  
8 testing administration fee as may be determined by the Director of the  
9 Department of Arkansas State Police to recover the costs of administering the  
10 testing program and examination distribution expenses.
