## For An Act To Be Entitled

10 AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR CONTINUED

27 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
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29 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - ARKANSAS BETTER CHANCE FOR SCHOOL SUCCESS  
30 PROGRAM. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Education, to be  
31 payable from the Department of Education Public School Fund Account, for  
32 continued expansion of the Arkansas Better Chance for School Success Program  
33 beyond the services provided for during the Second Extraordinary Session of  
34 2003 by the 84th General Assembly for the biennial period ending June 30,

SECTION 2. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CARRY FORWARD. Any unexpended balance of appropriation and funds authorized by this Act for the Arkansas Better Chance for School Success Program remaining on June 30,2006 shall be carried forward into the following fiscal year to be used for the same purposes. Any unexpended funds allocated for the Arkansas Better Chance for School Success Program remaining on June 30, 2007, in the Department of Education Public School Fund Account shall be designated and retained for the Arkansas Better Chance for School Success Program.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2005 through June 30, 2007.

SECTION 3. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
